Governor Nicole Kringstad

- 3 R's- Retain, Recruit, Rebrand
 - **Retain** we have on an average lost 6-7% of our membership year after year for the last, for the last 5 years
 - If we aren't retaining the members, we currently have a problem
 - Yes, lives change, people move, people get busy but most CRA reports come in saying people are leaving due to Lack of Interest
 - What are we doing to lose their interest? Are we not providing what

they are looking for? Are we sitting stuck in our old ways and not exploring new projects and ideas?

- We have lost 34 members so far this year, 90% due to lack of interest
- As leaders we need to work to retain these members. Maybe you send out a survey to your club to see what they would be interested in, or giving those members you haven't see for awhile a call to check in
- o **Recruit-** Currently DMM has 1646 members
- The good news is we have brought in 31 new members for a net of negative 3 so far
- New membership incentive, if the district is a net + then the clubs with a positive in membership that quarter gets \$50 a member they brought in, excluding FOOs or Transfers. Document will be sent out
- Hold a NOW meeting NOW, so many clubs have holiday projects coming up, now is the time to get them involved and active right away
- Every new member (not FOOs) is receiving a handwritten not from the Governor. We want those members to feel welcomed right away and get them involved. It will help with retention!
- New club building- working to add clubs in MN, JOI Club in Thompson
- Rebrand-Let's stop being the best kept secret and start being the best-known service organization
- Post and share what you do on your club's Facebook pages
- Submit big things to the local newspaper
- Wear your Optimist gear when out and about, especially at your projects!
- Post about it on your personal social media-don't hide the work you and your club do, brag it up, let people know about it!
- Make sure to use your club's logo on your documents

Preliminary 2021-2022 Year-End Report

- District down 6%
- Dues Aging Report: There are two clubs in the 61-90 days past due on dues; 5 clubs in the 91-120 days, and one JOI club in the 120+ days past due at close of business on 9/30/2022. Outreach to all clubs was initiated to confirm status and action plans

DMM 2021-2022 Year-End Financial Reports.

- Linnea Solem (35-140) shared that Don Berger (35-131), Greg Holn (35-235) and Darin Allen (35-075) are who Past Governor Steve Severance (35-075) picked to be on the Financial Review Committee for 2021-2022. They meet earlier today
- Terry Gorman (35-232) asked why Legacy money for 2nd quarter was not used as recommended- Linnea Solem (35-140) responded money can not be requested after an expense has occurred.
- Linnea Solem (35-140) shared at 3rd Quarter she shared a guideline for requesting funds from the Legacy Funds
- Linnea Solem (35-140) presented the preliminary financials as presented, 2nd by Susan Fix (35-204) with Final review being done by end of November from the Review Committee.

Vote to approve DMM 2022-23 Budget

- Governor Nicole Kringstad and DST Carmen Bakken (Finance Committee) prepared and submitted the 2022-20223 budget to the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee reviewed the proposed budget and recommended to accept the preliminary budget to the Board of Directors at the Q1 DMM District Meeting.
 - Income Line Items: 140-Oratorical, 141-CCDHH,147-Essay where deleted as funds will come for OI Restricted Funds
 - Disbursements Line Items: 370-Oratorical, 370.1-International Oratorical, 371-CCDHH, 373-JOOI, 380-Junior Golf, 390-Essay were deleted as funds came from OI Restricted Funds
 - Disbursements Line Items: 510-Lt Governors Int'l Convention, 540-Gov-Candidate Int'l Convention, 561-OI Ambassador Int'l Convention, 562-Committee Chairs Int'l Convention, 563 Officer Int'l Convention were Deleted due to district needing to make cuts to balance budget.
- Motion to open discussion on DMM 2022-2023 Budget by Linnea Solem (35-140) and seconded by Susan Fix (35-204)
- Budget discussion:
 - Motion by Ken Munch (35-234) to Combine the two Restricted Golf funds into one, 2nd by Terry Gorman (35-232)
 - Discussion by Jo-Anne Pelzer (35-153) asked what OI would need to have above happen, Linnea Solem (35-140) said it was a simple process.
 - Linnea Solem (35-140) mentioned the Governor needs to name who the person is to request funds from OI, Governor Nicole Kringstad appointed S/T Carmen Bakken- paperwork will be sent into OI.
 - Linnea also mentioned she shared the draft process at the 2021-2022 3rd Quarter Executive Meeting
 - Motion Carried
 - Motion by Terry Gorman (35-232) to add Line Item 561-OI Ambassador back into budget -No 2nd so motion Died
 - Star Munch (35-150) asked for clarification on Oratorical- No fees will be charge to contestant for food or Contest, but Sponsor clubs are reliable for Mileage, Rooms, Guest Meals.
 - Lizz Paulson (35-227) asked for clarification on Lt Governors-Mileage was estimated from Lt Governors home to each Conference and Convention and then subtracted in half as only half of the Lt. Governors attend.
 - Drew Campbell (35-229) had same question as Lizz except for Committee Chairs
 - Fred Urso (35-143) had questions where Line 470 Communications, Marketing and Technology number came from and asked for a break down. Linnea Solem (35-140) Provided the breakdown from prior year.
 - Star Munch (35-150) asked if committee chairs had access to Constant Contact. It was recommended to info to DST Carmen Bakken (35-166) and she will mail out info for Committee Chairs
 - Don Berger (35-131) reframed from voting- agreed with budget but not that items

stated in District Bylaws, can be changed without Special Convention

Motion to Accept Budget as discussed by Carmen Bakken (35-166), 2nd by Jim Bisek (35-131)

Approve 2023 DMM Convention at Spearfish SD August 17-19
